Community Refugee Dinners and Beyond this Summer

Opportunities to share fun and time with refugee claimants this summer - Please consider and let Ruth know if you would like to participate.

- **Community dinner co-ordination:** Each Wednesday night we host an outdoor dinner with purchased meals at Burnaby Civic Centre park. We are looking for several volunteers to help with some of the food ordering or pick up, or arranging the picnic area with the current Covid precaution measures

(spacing out seating, providing hand sanitizer). If we have a team then we can take turns and not do each week.



- **Attending Community dinner:** Enjoy a free picnic (Wednesdays, see above) and get to know some wonderful newcomers who are keen to find community and friendship. We can pray for our new friends and see how the Lord leads and grows Shalom and connections. Sign up with the e-vite so the right amount of food is ordered.
- **Community clubs:** We also are encouraging volunteers to meet regularly with refugees in small groups to do an activity. We're looking for leaders to partner with a refugee claimant to host a series of activities such as hikes, biking, photography, beach walks, sports, swimming, art, book club ... anything you enjoy doing and can share the enjoyment with others. It would be great if these activities happened regularly-- every week or every 2 weeks for up to 8 sessions, so that you could get to know the participants well. The communication around these activities would happen on the WhatsApp group chat that most of the refugee friends use. You can join the WhatsApp group or let the office know, and it be put on WhatsApp.
- **Other activities:** You could host a one-time event such as berry picking or exploring a part of Vancouver. Communication would also be through the WhatsApp group. Let the office know you are able to share an activity and we will find the refugee friends!

There is some grant money to help with costs. (Of the refugee's part, not the whole group's costs.)
