Mennonite World Conference Assembly



The upcoming (hybrid) Mennonite World Conference Assembly that will be taking place in Indonesia, July 5-10. MWC has generally held a global assembly every six years. This assembly was originally planned for 2021, but was postponed to 2022 because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

This year we will be about 700 people in-person, but will have thousands of on-line participants.

Assembly Theme: "Following Jesus Together Across Barriers."

With most people participating virtually we are encouraging those who remain at home to experience the assembly in community, rather than alone at one's computer. Some congregations are exploring how they can still experience MWC Assembly communally by joining together with other congregations for "watch/viewing parties."
